



New public housing proposed for New Plymouth



To meet the growing demand for warm, dry homes, Kāinga Ora is looking at some of the properties we already own, for potential redevelopment of new housing.

More homes will help meet the urgent need for public housing and means getting more families out of unstable living conditions and into a warm, dry and healthy place to call home.

Our early plans suggest we could deliver more than 100 new homes across New Plymouth, focusing initially on the suburbs of Westtown, Frankleigh Park, Brooklands, Vogeltown and Spotswood.

We are looking at housing opportunities in:

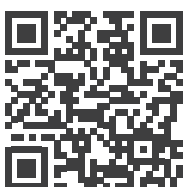
