Thank you for your email dated 12 September 2022, to the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and transferred to Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities on 19 September 2022 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

1. *Can you please provide a breakdown of how much money has been paid out on First Home Grants and First Home Loans, since 2017?*
2. *Can you please break it down by how much was paid out per year, how many people or couples it was paid out to per year?*
3. *Can you also please break down how much has been paid out per region per year, and also how many people/couples it has been paid out to per region per year?*

First Home Grants

1. *Breakdown of how much money has been paid out on First Home Grants since 2017*

First Home Grants are paid out to qualifying individuals purchasing or building a home. If there are two or more purchasers of the property, each individual purchaser can receive a grant if they qualify for one. The amount of each grant varies from \$3,000 to \$10,000 depending on how long the applicant has been contributing to KiwiSaver and the type of property they are buying or building.
